The goal is simple and always the same: Get them in the restroom!

On the walk there, ask questions! For ex: (What's important to you in your restroom? How do you handle cleaning it now? Anything you struggle to keep up with? What is the one thought you have before walking in your restroom?)

What we provide is a weekly service to sanitize and disinfect your restroom. Let me walk you through our process:

- 1. We start with a low-grade acid wash of all your fixtures (toilets, sinks, urinals). This is to remove any uric scale, bacteria, or mold buildup. (Use your phone or a mirror to show them)
- 2. Then we apply a germicidal coating that acts as a barrier similar to Rain-X.

 This helps prevent anything from sticking to the fixtures until our next service.
- 3. Next, we use a microfiber mop on your floors to clean them and eliminate bacteria and germs.
- 4. Once that is complete, we use an Electro-static sprayer with a hospital grade disinfectant which coats every inch of the restroom and brings the bacteria count to zero.
- 5. Where do you buy your soap? We provide free soap, air freshener and urinal screens. Every week we will be refilling the soap and air freshener. We provide the dispensers as well.

The next step of our service is our floor scrub. Our goal is to get your tile and grout sanitized, disinfected and looking the best it possibly can.

- 1. We apply a heavy degreaser to the floor.
- 2. We utilize a Kaivac machine, deck scrubbers and rotary scrubbers to clean your floor, tile, and grout and also up to 5 feet up the walls.
- 3. Lastly, the Kaivac machine allows us to vacuum up all the resulting dirty water on the floor. What this means is we are <u>removing</u> the germs as opposed to moving them around like a traditional mop will.



Keep your head on a swivel!

Be sure to look for:

- > Broken Dispensers
- > Empty Dispensers
- Drain Flies
- Sticky Floors
- Dirty tile and grout (bathroom, front of house, back of house)
- > Excess Paper Product
